- **Activity Reporting Consistency;** Consistency of reporting all activities on timely manners
- **Technical Issue Escalation;** Immediate escalation of the major technical issues which present risk for airport operations and level of services to the workshop manager
- **Task and Inspection Optimization;** Propose and modification for the task list and inspection form make it more relevant and efficient
- **Internal Communication;** Communicate internally on the progress of preventive and corrective maintenance work.
